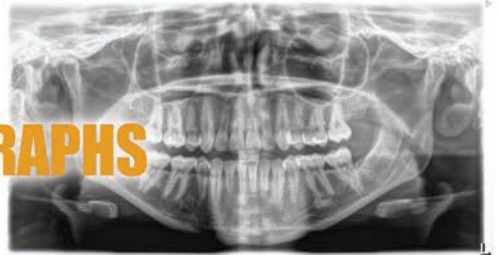

## DIGITAL RADIOGRAPHS



We learn a lot about your oral health through a visual examination of your teeth and gums.

Even with 20/20 vision, there are things that can't be seen with the naked eye. Technological tools are invaluable in helping us detect potential trouble, and by far the most effective of these is the dental radiograph, or x-ray. It enables the dentist to detect, diagnose, and plan treatment long before problems become visible to the naked eye.

Digital x-rays using the dental panoramic radiograph uses less radiation than traditional panoramic x-rays. The panoramic radiograph sends signals to a computer which translates them into large, crisp, electronic pictures of your teeth, supporting bones, and gums. The pictures can be enlarged, immediately viewed and stored for future reference.

## Organ Donation

There are more than 8,000 people in Pennsylvania who are on a waiting list for a life-saving organ transplant.

This past year two of our staff members were personally faced with decisions on organ donation. Carol's brother was born with one functioning kidney, and at the age of 7 after an emergency trip to CHOP, one kidney was removed. Forty- five years later her brother's only kidney began to fail, he spent the last two years on dialysis. After other family members were not able to donate, Carol was accepted into the U of Penn donor exchange program. In November her brother received a live donor kidney and in December she reciprocated.

In 2011 Roseanne's twin granddaughters were born, one had been born with a heart condition which would require several surgeries. The first surgery, when she was 4 months old. This past February during one of her surgeries something went terribly wrong during her procedure and she had to be put on life support. On Friday February 13, National Organ Donor Day, Roseanne's granddaughter received her new heart. After 52 days at CHOP she came home on Easter weekend. A sweet, loving little girl, again playing with her sister and enjoying her favorite things. The community came together and a fund was set up to help the family, there also was an auction, a fund raiser, and some of the staff held a bake sale. Roseanne and her family feel very blessed with the out pouring of support and this gift of life.
